<sup>1</sup> The old system under t	he law of Moses was only a	
shadow, a dim preview of the good things to come,		
not the good things the	mselves. The sacrifices under	
hat system were repeated again and again, year after		
year, but they were never able to provide perfect		
cleansing for those who	came to worship. 2If they	
could have provided perfect cleansing, the sacrifices		
would have stopped, for the worshipers would have		
been purified once for all time, and their feelings of		
guilt would have disapp	eared. <sup>3</sup> But instead, those	
sacrifices actually remin	nded them of their sins year	
after year. 4For it is not	possible for the blood of bulls	
and goats to take away	sins.	
5That is why when Chri	st came into the world. He said	
That is why, when Christ came into the world, He said to God, "You did not want animal sacrifices or sin		
offerings. But You have given Me a body to offer. <sup>6</sup> You		
were not pleased with burnt offerings or other		
offerings for sin. <sup>7</sup> Then I said, 'Look, I have come to do		
Your Will, O God—as is written about Me in the		
Scriptures." 8First, Christ said, "You did not want		
animal sacrifices or sin offerings or burnt offerings or		
other offerings for sin, nor were You pleased with		
them" (though they are required by the law of Moses). <sup>9</sup> Then He said, "Look, I have come to do Your Will." He cancels the first covenant in order to put the		
second into effect. 10Fo	r God's Will was for us to be	
made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ,		
once for all time.		
11 Indor the old covers	at the priest stands and	
<sup>11</sup> Under the old covenant, the priest stands and ministers before the altar day after day, offering the		
same sacrifices again and again, which can never take		
away sins. 12But our High Priest offered Himself to		
God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time.		
Then He sat down in the place of honor at God's right		
hand. <sup>13</sup> There He waits until His enemies are humbled		
and made a footstool under His feet. <sup>14</sup> For by that one		
offering he forever made perfect those who are being		
made holy. <sup>15</sup> And the Holy Spirit also testifies that this		-
is so. For he says, <sup>16</sup> "This is the new covenant I will		
make with My people on that day, says the Lord: I will
